COVID-19 UPDATE

Letter to Parents

Dear Parents,

I am sure you are aware that COVID-19 cases in the local area are unfortunately rising again. As schools are beginning to close for the summer holidays, Rompers will remain open as normal and therefore it is critical that more than ever, we continue to protect our Rompers bubble as we have done so well for the last 18 months.

To support this, we wish to be clear to parents our protocol at Rompers.

- If your child is feeling unwell and presenting COVID-19 symptoms, they should have a PCR test and should remain off nursery until the result return.
We would kindly ask that you inform us by email if your child is going for a PCR test.
- If someone in the household or someone in which your child has been in contact with has tested positive via a PCR test, they should not attend Rompers and a PCR test should be completed.
- If someone in the household or someone in which your child has been in contact with is awaiting a PCR test result due to presenting symptoms, they should not attend Rompers until the PCR test result comes back as negative.

If PCR results are **Negative**

- We require proof of the PCR test before they return to nursery

If PCR results are **Positive**

- Your child and family should follow Test and Protect guidelines for self-isolation
- We require proof of the positive PCR test before they return to nursery following self-isolation
